Crossroads House is...

A home filled with love and support with our staff and volunteers providing individualized care for those who have been medically determined to be in the last three months of their lives.

An alternative to hospital or nursing home stay when care can no longer be provided in their own home.

Our Aim...

Is to provide personalized care and support to the resident and their family in a homelike setting.

Our approach is holistic: physical, emotional, spiritual, and social needs are addressed, affirming a dignified quality of life.

The Resident, Family & Friends...

Are encouraged to participate in the decision making process regarding all aspects of end-of-life care.

Crossroads House Admission...

Is available at any time, for up to two residents who reside in Genesee, Wyoming, and surrounding counties.

Preference is given to those who can no longer be cared for in their own home.

Admission is based solely on need, regardless of religion, age, sex or race.

Each resident must be under the care of a certified home health agency for proper medical care case management.

Staff...

Is composed of Registered Nurses, Licensed Practical Nurses and Aides, all complemented by specially trained and dedicated volunteers.

Referrals...

Can come from physicians, hospital social workers, discharge planners, health care agencies, clergy, individuals, family members or any other source.
